

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- If conditions warrant, the **SNOW EMERGENCY** will remain in effect for another 48 hours. The **PARKING RESTRICTIONS WILL START OVER**. If this should arise, the city will advise you through the media and city websites.
- In addition to the 48-hour **SNOW EMERGENCY** parking restrictions, the City may restrict parking in designated areas for special snow removal. **IN THESE CASES**, signs will be posted for all to see.

- Residents are reminded that sidewalks adjacent to their property must be cleared of snow by 10:00am the day following the end of the storm.
- Residents are requested to refrain from throwing snow into traffic lanes. Violators may be fined.
- Residents are requested to not place regular garbage in the right of way during a **SNOW EMERGENCY** – recycling collection will be suspended during a **SNOW EMERGENCY**.

CITY OF TROY, NY SNOW EMERGENCY PLAN

Regulations & Restrictions

- When conditions warrant, the mayor will declare a **SNOW EMERGENCY** which will begin at either 8am or 8pm and will be in effect on **DESIGNATED SNOW EMERGENCY STREETS ONLY**
- All radio and television stations will be advised and will announce that the city of Troy **SNOW EMERGENCY** is in effect at either 8am or 8pm.
- This announcement will give residents enough time to move vehicles in accordance with emergency postings – approximately 8-10 hours.
- Normal parking rules and regulations are temporarily suspended on **DESIGNATED SNOW EMERGENCY STREETS ONLY**.
- During the first 24 hours of the **SNOW EMERGENCY, PARKING ON THE ODD NUMBERED SIDE OF THE DESIGNATED STREET IS PROHIBITED (UNLESS OTHERWISE POSTED)**. Vehicles in violation will be ticketed and towed.
- Crews will proceed with snow plowing operations on the **ODD NUMBERED** side of the street for the first 24 hours.
- Crews will then proceed with snow plowing operations on the **EVEN NUMBERED** side of the street for the second 24 hours. During the second 24-hour period of the **SNOW EMERGENCY, PARKING ON THE EVEN NUMBERED SIDE OF THE DESIGNATED STREET IS PROHIBITED (UNLESS OTHERWISE POSTED)**.
- After 48 hours have passed from the initial **SNOW EMERGENCY** time designation, the emergency will be officially over unless circumstances warrant additional time.
- **CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT** parking restrictions remain in effect as currently posted unless otherwise notified.
- Residents with driveways are requested to park their vehicles in their driveway during a declared **SNOW EMERGENCY**.
- Regular garbage should not be placed in the right of way during a declared **SNOW EMERGENCY**. Recycling collection will be suspended during the declared **SNOW EMERGENCY**.
